### THE SERIES

- This is the 29th meeting between Virginia Tech and Florida State. The Hokies and Seminoles have a long history as both teams were previously members of the Metro Conference.
- The last meeting between Tech and Florida State was Jan. 8, 2012. The Hokies fell 75-40 at Cassell Coliseum. LaTorri Hines-Allen had a career-high 17 points. Alyssa Fenyn added eight points, three assists, two steals and a block. Aerial Wilson had five assists. The Seminoles had five players in double-digits including Natasha Howard's team-leading 16 points. Cierra Brevard notched a double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds.

### THE HOKIES

- Tech fell to Clemson, 55-51 the last time out. The Hokies forced 26 turnovers and pulled down a season-best 28 offensive rebounds, but were unable to convert, shooting just 21.5 percent (17-of-79) from the field. Aerial Wilson led with 14 points while Monet Tellier and Porschia Hadley added 16 and 10 points, respectively. LaTorri Hines-Allen set a career-high in rebounds for the second straight game with 16, including 10 on the offensive glass.
- The Hokies are being led this season by Tellier who is averaging 14.3 points per game, Wilson is adding 10.8 points and handing out 3.2 assists per game. Alyssa Fenyn is putting up numbers all around with 7.7 points, 4.8 rebounds, 2.7 assists and 1.7 steals per game. LaTorri Hines-Allen is grabbing a team-best 7.1 rebounds per game including an 8.0 mark against ACC opponents. She is averaging 3.7 offensive rebounds per game in ACC play and ranks third in the conference.

### THE SEMINOLES

- FSU fell to Virginia, 62-52, the last time out. Cierra Brevard had 12 points for the Seminoles while Natasha Howard and Alexa Deluzio each had six rebounds. The Seminoles trailed by one, 26-25 at the break before the Cavaliers outscored them 36-27 in the second half in Charlottesville, Va.
- Brevard leads the Seminoles with 14.4 points per game. Deluzio is adding 13.3 points. Natasha Howard is pulling down a team best 8.9 rebounds per game.

**UP NEXT:** Virginia Tech has eight days off before hosting Boston College on Monday, Feb. 13 in a 7 p.m. game at Cassell Coliseum.





## NOTEWORTHY

## IN THE RECORD BOOKS

Tech recorded just its third win all-time against a team ranked in the top-8 when the Hokies defeated No. 8/7 Maryland, 75-69 on Jan. 26. The other two wins were in 1998 against No. 6 Duke and in 1985 against No. 5 Old Dominion.

## I'LL TAKE THAT

The Hokies forced 20 turnovers by the Terrapins, resulting in 26 points. Tech also grabbed 19 offensive rebounds for 20 second-chance points.

## TAKING CHARITY

The Hokies had one of their best performances of the season from the free throw line against Miami on Jan. 23. Tech shot 80 percent on 16-of-20.

## SOLID SECOND HALF

**LATORRI HINES-ALLEN** scored 11 of her career-high 17 points in the second half against Florida State on Jan. 8. She led all scorers in the game.

## OFF TO A STRONG START

With the win against Boston College, the Hokies improved to 2-0 in the ACC. Tech is off to its best start in the ACC as this marks the first time the Hokies have started conference play with a 2-0 record since joining the league in 2004-05.

## HOKIE CLASSIC

This year's Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic marks the 22nd consecutive year for the tournament, which began in 1990 as the Diamond Club Classic and was known as the Lady Luck Classic from 2000-2006 and the Hokie Hardwood Classic in 2007-08.

## HOME SWEET HOME

Tech picked up its first home win on Dec. 11 with a 70-58 win over NC Central in Cassell Coliseum.

## CAREER HIGH WEEK

**LATORRI HINES-ALLEN** set a career-high 12 rebounds on the road against Penn State on Dec. 6. She followed that up with a career-high in points on Dec. 11 against NC Central with 14. Hines-Allen also recorded her first career double-double in the game, adding 10 rebounds.

## BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE

**AERIAL WILSON** led the Hokies against the Hawkeyes, tying a career-high 18 points. In addition, she handed out four assists and grabbed four boards. **MONET TELLIER** added 16 points for Tech in a hard fought, 58-47 loss in Iowa City, Iowa. Freshman **LARRYQUA HALL** pulled down a career-high eight rebounds and **LATORRI HINES-ALLEN** also grabbed eight boards for the Hokies.

## OFF THE BENCH

Freshman **LARRYQUA HALL** came into the Minnesota game and played 22 minutes, scoring seven points, grabbing four rebounds and picking up two steals.

## HITTING 30

Sophomore guard **MONET TELLIER** hit a new career-high with 31 points on Nov. 21 against William & Mary. She hit 13-of-22 from the field, including 2-of-4 from three point range and went 3-of-5 from the line.

## DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIME

Junior guard **ALYSSA FENYN** posted her first double-double of the season with 11 points and 11 rebounds against George Washington on Nov. 19.

Assistant Coach **CHANTELLE ANDERSON** played six season in the WNBA and overseas while suiting up for the Sacramento Monarchs, San Antonio Silverstars and the Atlanta Dream. Prior to her professional days, she was a four-year standout and three-time All-American at Vanderbilt where she set the all-time scoring record with 2,600 points.

## VIRGINIA TECH HEAD COACH DENNIS WOLFF



## DENNIS WOLFF

Head Coach ▪ First Season  
Connecticut, 1978

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut. Matt played basketball at Boston University and Michael plays ice hockey for Brown.
