The Hokies will be wearing pink for the game against Boston College in order to support Play 4Kay. It is an opportunity for women's basketball teams across the nation to raise awareness and funds for breast cancer. The official charity is the Kay Yow Cancer Fund in partnership with The V Foundation and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association.

THE SERIES

- This is the 18th meeting between Virginia Tech and Boston College.

- The last meeting between Tech and BC was Jan. 5, 2012. The Hokies defeated the Eagles 38-35 at Conte Forum. Monet Tellier had 15 points for the Hokies. LaTorri Hines-Allen grabbed eight rebounds. BC was led by Joy Caracciolo with eight points and Kristen Doherty pulled down eight boards.

THE HOKIES

- Tech fell to FSU, 78-60 the last time out. The Hokies were within eight (61-53) with 6:33 remaining, but the Seminoles closed out the game with a run to secure the win. Tech was led by Porschia Hadley with a career-high 18 points. Monet Tellier added 17 points and Aerial Wilson had 16. The Hokies turned the ball over just eight times while forcing 18.

- The Hokies are being led this season by Tellier who is averaging 14.4 points per game. Aerial Wilson is adding 11.0 points and handing out 3.2 assists per game. Alyssa Fenyn is putting up numbers all around with 7.4 points, 4.9 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 1.7 steals per game. LaTorri Hines-Allen is grabbing a team-best 6.9 rebounds per game including an 7.5 mark against ACC opponents.

THE EAGLES

- BC fell to Duke, 71-62, the last time out. Kristen Doherty had 17 points and five rebounds for the Eagles. Shayra Brown added 12 points and Kate Zenevitch had 11. Boston College trailed by just one, 32-31, at the break, but the Blue Devils held on, outscoring the Eagles 39-31 in the second half.

- Zenevitch leads the Eagles with 10.3 points and pulling down a team-best 6.5 rebounds per game. Doherty is adding 9.5 points. Tiffany Ruffin is handing out 2.6 assists per game.

UP NEXT: Virginia Tech will travel to Durham, N.C. to face Duke on Wednesday, Feb. 15 at 7 p.m. in Cameron Indoor Stadium.

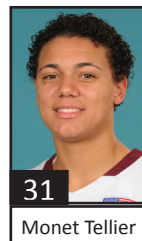

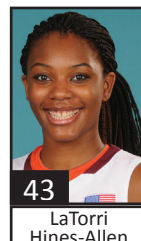

In a four game span (Maryland, NC State, Clemson and Florida State), Tech has pulled down 81 offensive rebounds to their opponents' 52 offensive boards. The Hokies grabbed a season-high 28 offensive boards against Clemson.

I'LL TAKE THAT

In the same four game span, the Hokies are forcing 20.8 turnovers per game while turning the ball over just 10.3 times per game.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS

Tech recorded just its third win all-time against a team ranked in the top-8 when the Hokies defeated No. 8/7 Maryland, 75-69 on Jan. 26. The other two wins were in 1998 against No. 6 Duke and in 1985 against No. 5 Old Dominion.

TAKING CHARITY

The Hokies had one of their best performances of the season from the free throw line against Miami on Jan. 23. Tech shot 80 percent on 16-of-20.

SOLID SECOND HALF

LATORRI HINES-ALLEN scored 11 of her career-high 17 points in the second half against Florida State on Jan. 8. She led all scorers in the game.

OFF TO A STRONG START

With the win against Boston College, the Hokies improved to 2-0 in the ACC. Tech is off to its best start in the ACC as this marks the first time the Hokies have started conference play with a 2-0 record since joining the league in 2004-05.

ACC TIP-OFF

The Hokies got the ACC season off to a strong start, picking up a 55-33 win over Clemson on Jan. 2. Tech jumped out to an early 32-3 lead in the first half. The Lady Tigers closed the gap to 16 in the second half, but the Hokies responded with a 9-0 run to seal the win. **AERIAL WILSON** tallied a game and career-high 24 points.

CLASSIC WIN

Tech defeated UMBC 57-52 on the second day of the Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic. **MONET TELLIER** had 18 points. **LARRYQUA HALL** pulled down a game and career-high 11 rebounds for the Hokies.

HOKIE CLASSIC

This year's Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic marks the 22nd consecutive year for the tournament, which began in 1990 as the Diamond Club Classic and was known as the Lady Luck Classic from 2000-2006 and the Hokie Hardwood Classic in 2007-08.

HOME SWEET HOME

Tech picked up its first home win on Dec. 11 with a 70-58 win over NC Central in Cassell Coliseum.

CAREER HIGH WEEK

LATORRI HINES-ALLEN set a career-high 12 rebounds on the road against Penn State on Dec. 6. She followed that up with a career-high in points on Dec. 11 against NC Central with 14. Hines-Allen also recorded her first career double-double in the game, adding 10 rebounds.

BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE

AERIAL WILSON led the Hokies against the Hawkeyes, tying a career-high 18 points. In addition, she handed out four assists and grabbed four boards. **MONET TELLIER** added 16 points for Tech in a hard fought, 58-47 loss in Iowa City, Iowa. Freshman **LARRYQUA HALL** pulled down a career-high eight rebounds and **LATORRI HINES-ALLEN** also grabbed eight boards for the Hokies.

BIG TEN/VIRGINIA TECH CHALLENGE??

The Hokies played three straight games against teams from the Big Ten, starting with Minnesota at the SMC Concord Hilton Tournament. In the stretch, Tech faced Iowa in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, followed by Penn State in a road game.

ALL-TOURNAMENT HONORS

MONET TELLIER picked up All-Tournament honors at the SMC Concord Hilton Tournament hosted by St. Mary's in Moraga, Calif. The sophomore guard averaged 20.5 points, pulled down 11 rebounds, dished out six assists and grabbed seven steals in the two game span.

OFF THE BENCH

Freshman **LARRYQUA HALL** came into the Minnesota game and played 22 minutes, scoring seven points, grabbing four rebounds and picking up two steals.

HITTING 30

Sophomore guard **MONET TELLIER** hit a new career-high with 31 points on Nov. 21 against William & Mary. She hit 13-of-22 from the field, including 2-of-4 from three point range and went 3-of-5 from the line.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIME

Junior guard **ALYSSA FENYN** posted her first double-double of the season with 11 points and 11 rebounds against George Washington on Nov. 19.

BACK-TO-BACK CAREER GAMES

After setting a career scoring high in the opening game of the season, junior **AERIAL WILSON** put up another career-high in the second game, scoring 18 points against Charlotte on Nov. 16.

STRONG START

MONET TELLIER knocked down 29 points in the Hokies' season opening, 77-65 win over Old Dominion on Nov. 11. Tellier posted 20 of her 29 in the first half. In the final minutes of the game, Tellier went 3-of-4 from the free throw line and sank a jumper to help Tech hold off the Monarchs' late run.

CAREER NUMBERS

Junior **AERIAL WILSON** set a career-high 16 points against Old Dominion on Nov. 11.

OPENING SUCCESS

The Hokies defeated Old Dominion, 77-65 on Friday, Nov. 11 in the season opener. With the win, Tech improved to 28-8 all-time in season starts.

SHE'S BACK

Redshirt sophomore **PORSCHIA HADLEY**, who missed all but eight games last season due to knee surgery, returns to provide support in the paint. As a freshman in 2009-10, Hadley averaged 4.4 points, 2.9 rebounds and set a career-high 15 points at then-No. 10 Florida State. She also set a career-high four blocks in an upset victory over then-No. 10 North Carolina. In the eight games she played during her sophomore season, Hadley averaged 4.3 points, 4.9 rebounds and one block per game.

A FENYN RETURN

Junior **ALYSSA FENYN** is the top returning scorer for the Hokies, averaging 9.4 points per game last season. In addition she was second in assists with 67. Fenyn set career highs with 17 points against Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Virginia.

TELLIER LOOKS TO BUILD OFF FRESHMAN YEAR

Sophomore **MONET TELLIER** returns after a solid freshman season. The guard averaged 8.0 points and 4.1 rebounds per game last season and was second on the team in steals with 41. Tellier set career highs with 23 points against Vanderbilt and NC State.

AERIAL ATTACK

Junior **AERIAL WILSON** will guide the Hokies on the court this season, playing point guard. During the 2010-11 season she set a career-high 14 points against Minnesota in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge. She also set a career-high eight assists against Alcorn State.

WELCOME TO THE HOKIES

Head Coach **DENNIS WOLFF** is in his first season as head coach of the Virginia Tech women's basketball team. He was previously the head men's basketball coach at Boston University where he guided the Terriers to a 247-197 record and three straight conference titles.

POWER PLAYER

Assistant Coach **CHANTELLE ANDERSON** played six season in the WNBA and overseas while suiting up for the Sacramento Monarchs, San Antonio Silverstars and the Atlanta Dream. Prior to her professional days, she was a four-year standout and three-time All-American at Vanderbilt where she set the all-time scoring record with 2,600 points.

LISTENING TO THE HOKIES

The Hokies again have a commercial radio package. All of Tech's women's basketball games can be heard in the Blacksburg-Christiansburg-Radford market on 100.7 WNMX FM. Andrew Allegretta will handle the play-by-play duties in his first season with the team.

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut. Matt played basketball at Boston University and Michael plays ice hockey for Brown.
