THE SERIES

- This marks just the 18th meeting between the two teams.
- Virginia Tech and Wake Forest last met on Feb. 6, 2011. The Demon Deacons claimed a 60-55 decision over Virginia Tech in Blacksburg. The Hokies were led by Alyssa Fenyn with 18 points. Wake Forest was led by Secily Ray and Lakevia Boykin with 13 points each.
- The Hokies last win against the Demon Deacons was February 22, 2009 when Virginia Tech defeated Wake Forest 79-55 in Blacksburg, Va.

THE HOKIES

- Virginia Tech fell to No. 17/19 Georgia Tech, 77-66 the last time out. The Hokies had one of their best shooting nights of the season, hitting 46.2 percent from the field as four players hit double digits. Aerial Wilson led with 21 points while Alyssa Fenyn added 13. Monet Tellier and Porschia Hadley recorded 12 and 11, respectively.
- The Hokies are being led this season by Monet Tellier who is averaging 13.5 points per game. Aerial Wilson is adding 12.1 points and handing out 2.9 assists per game. Alyssa Fenyn is putting up numbers all around with 7.6 points, 4.7 rebounds, 2.9 assists and 1.6 steals per game. LaTorri Hines-Allen is grabbing a team-best 7.0 rebounds per game including a 7.4 mark against ACC opponents.

THE DEMON DEACONS

- Wake Forest dropped a 61-55 decision to Virginia in its last game. Chelsea Douglas came off the bench for a team-high 19 points. Secily Ray added nine points and grabbed a game-best 11 rebounds.
- Lakevia Boykin leads the Demon Deacons with 11.8 points per game. Chelsea Douglas is adding 10.3 points per game. Secily Ray leads the team with 7.2 rebounds while Brooke Thomas is handing out 3.9 assists per game.

UP NEXT: Virginia Tech will open the Atlantic Coast Conference women's basketball tournament on Thursday, March 1 at the Greensboro Coliseum.

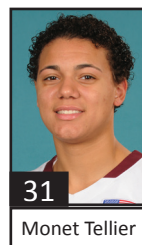

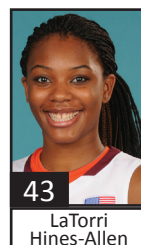

NOTEWORTHY

HOT SHOOTING

The Hokies had their best shooting performance of the season against No. 17/19 Georgia Tech. Virginia Tech connected on 46.2 percent from the field on 24-of-52 from the field.

ON A ROLL

AERIAL WILSON recorded her ninth consecutive double-digit scoring game. The streak began with Miami on Jan. 23 and the ninth game came against Georgia Tech on Feb. 23. During the span, the Hokies faced four ranked teams.

OFFENSIVE BOARDS

In a four game span (Maryland, NC State, Clemson and Florida State), Tech has pulled down 81 offensive rebounds to their opponents' 52 offensive boards. The Hokies grabbed a season-high 28 offensive boards against Clemson.

I'LL TAKE THAT

In the same four game span, the Hokies are forcing 20.8 turnovers per game while turning the ball over just 10.3 times per game.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS

Tech recorded just its third win all-time against a team ranked in the top-8 when the Hokies defeated No. 8/7 Maryland, 75-69 on Jan. 26. The other two wins were in 1998 against No. 6 Duke and in 1985 against No. 5 Old Dominion.

TAKING CHARITY

SOLID SECOND HALF

LATORRI HINES-ALLEN scored 11 of her career-high 17 points in the second half against Florida State on Jan. 8. She led all scorers in the game.

OFF TO A STRONG START

With the win against Boston College, the Hokies improved to 2-0 in the ACC. Tech is off to its best start in the ACC as this marks the first time the Hokies have started conference play with a 2-0 record since joining the league in 2004-05.

ACC TIP-OFF

The Hokies got the ACC season off to a strong start, picking up a 55-33 win over Clemson on Jan. 2. Tech jumped out to an early 32-3 lead in the first half. The Lady Tigers closed the gap to 16 in the second half, but the Hokies responded with a 9-0 run to seal the win. **AERIAL WILSON** tallied a game and career-high 24 points.

CLASSIC WIN

Tech defeated UMBC 57-52 on the second day of the Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic. **MONET TELLIER** had 18 points. **LARRYQUA HALL** pulled down a game and career-high 11 rebounds for the Hokies.

HOKIE CLASSIC

This year's Hilton Garden Inn Hokie Classic marks the 22nd consecutive year for the tournament, which began in 1990 as the Diamond Club Classic and was known as the Lady Luck Classic from 2000-2006 and the Hokie Hardwood Classic in 2007-08.

HOME SWEET HOME

Tech picked up its first home win on Dec. 11 with a 70-58 win over NC Central in Cassell Coliseum.

CAREER HIGH WEEK

LATORRI HINES-ALLEN set a career-high 12 rebounds on the road against Penn State on Dec. 6. She followed that up with a career-high in points on Dec. 11 against NC Central with 14. Hines-Allen also recorded her first career double-double in the game, adding 10 rebounds.

BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE

AERIAL WILSON led the Hokies against the Hawkeyes, tying a career-high 18 points. In addition, she handed out four assists and grabbed four boards. **MONET TELLIER** added 16 points for Tech in a hard fought, 58-47 loss in Iowa City, Iowa. Freshman **LARRYQUA HALL** pulled down a career-high eight rebounds and **LATORRI HINES-ALLEN** also grabbed eight boards for the Hokies.

BIG TEN/VIRGINIA TECH CHALLENGE??

The Hokies played three straight games against teams from the Big Ten, starting with Minnesota at the SMC Concord Hilton Tournament. In the stretch, Tech faced Iowa in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, followed by Penn State in a road game.

ALL-TOURNAMENT HONORS

MONET TELLIER picked up All-Tournament honors at the SMC Concord Hilton Tournament hosted by St. Mary's in Moraga, Calif. The sophomore guard averaged 20.5 points, pulled down 11 rebounds, dished out six assists and grabbed seven steals in the two game span.

OFF THE BENCH

Freshman **LARRYQUA HALL** came into the Minnesota game and played 22 minutes, scoring seven points, grabbing four rebounds and picking up two steals.

HITTING 30

Sophomore guard **MONET TELLIER** hit a new career-high with 31 points on Nov. 21 against William & Mary. She hit 13-of-22 from the field, including 2-of-4 from three point range and went 3-of-5 from the line.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIME

Junior guard **ALYSSA FENYN** posted her first double-double of the season with 11 points and 11 rebounds against George Washington on Nov. 19.

BACK-TO-BACK CAREER GAMES

After setting a career scoring high in the opening game of the season, junior **AERIAL WILSON** put up another career-high in the second game, scoring 18 points against Charlotte on Nov. 16.

STRONG START

VIRGINIA TECH HEAD COACH DENNIS WOLFF**DENNIS WOLFF**

Head Coach ▪ First Season
Connecticut, 1978

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut. Matt played basketball at Boston University and Michael plays ice hockey for Brown.
