THE SERIES

- This marks the 31st meeting between the two teams.
- Florida State and Virginia Tech have a long history, dating back to the first meeting in 1979. Both teams were also previously members of the Metro Conference.
- FSU holds the lead in the all-time series at 21-9. The Hokies are 6-8 against the Seminoles at Cassell Coliseum.
- Florida State claimed the win earlier this season in Tallahassee with a 70-56 decision at the Tucker Center. The two teams were tied at 45 with 8:58 to play in the second half before the Seminoles used a 25-11 run to break open the scoring.
- Monet Tellier had 18 points for the Hokies. Uju Ugoka added 10 points and grabbed nine rebounds. Alexis Lloyd came off the bench for eight points and picked up three steals.
- Chelsea Davis had 19 points to lead four Seminoles in double-digit scoring. Davis also grabbed seven rebounds. Leonor Rodriguez added 14 while Alexa Deluzio added 13 points and seven boards. Chastity Clayton posted 12 points.

THE HOKIES

- Virginia Tech fell to #16/17 North Carolina, 72-50, the last time out.
- The Hokies were led by Monet Tellier who recorded 15 points, five rebounds and eight assists. Alexis Lloyd recorded a new career-high with 11 points and Uju Ugoka tallied 10 points. Alyssa Fenyn notched seven points and a team-high seven rebounds.
- Tellier has been solid for the Hokies all season, averaging 13 points, 5.6 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game. Uju Ugoka is adding 12.1 points and pulling down a team-best 8.3 rebounds in 13 games played for the Hokies. Fenyn is adding 6.2 ppg and handing out 2.8 apg.

THE SEMINOLES

- Florida State dropped a 61-50 decision to #5/4 Duke in the team's last outing.
- Alexa Deluzio posted 16 points for the Seminoles. Natasha Howard recorded a double-double with 15 points and 11 rebounds. Leonor Rodriguez tallied nine points.
- Rodriguez leads the Seminoles with 16.4 points per game. Deluzio is adding 13.9 ppg while Howard is posting 13.7 points and 7.9 rebounds per game. Davis and Chastity Clayton are averaging 13.4 and 11.1 ppg, respectively. Yashira Delgado is recording 4.6 assists per game.

UP NEXT: Virginia Tech will wrap up its road schedule, traveling to Wake Forest on Thursday, Feb. 28. Game time is set for 6:30 p.m. at Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum in Winston-Salem, N.C.

NOTEWORTHY

FENYN GAME

Senior **Alyssa Fenyn** had a solid game against Clemson on Feb. 17. She recorded eight points, pulled down a season-best nine rebounds, handed out five assists and picked up a season-high four steals.

HOT HANDS

Virginia Tech connected on 53.2 percent from the field, including a 70 percent (7-of-10) clip from outside the arc.

STREAK SNAPPED

The Hokies snapped a nine game losing streak when they beat Georgia Tech on Feb. 8 in Atlanta. **Monet Tellier** knocked down 24 points, grabbed five rebounds, handed out four assists and picked up two steals. **Aerial Wilson** tallied 11 points and **Alyssa Fenyn** had 10 points along with five assists. **Porschia Hadley** grabbed six rebounds.

ROAD TESTED

Beginning Jan. 3 with the game at Virginia through Feb. 8 (at Georgia Tech), the Hokies will have played seven of their 10 games in that span on the road.

SOLID DEFENSE

The Hokies held #4 Duke to 22 points below its season average on Jan. 16, allowing the Blue Devils just 56 points. Tech also held them below their shooting percentage for the season. Duke shot just 35.4 percent from the field, but is averaging 44.7 percent on the season.

SEEING DOUBLE

In her second game for the Hokies, **Uju Ugoka** recorded her first career double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds against North Carolina A&T on Dec. 28.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS

Junior transfer **Uju Ugoka** made quite the first impression in her debut game. The Lagos, Nigeria native dropped in 28 points, pulled down eight rebounds and picked up a pair of steals against Wake Forest on Dec. 22. Ugoka's 28 points marked a Cassell Coliseum record for most points against an ACC opponent. It was also the most points scored by a Hokie in their debut game.

STRONG START

The Hokies got off to a strong start in ACC competition, defeating Wake Forest, 73-52 at home on Dec. 22. It marked the first ACC home win for Tech since defeating Clemson, 70-69 on Feb. 25, 2010.

TWO MORE SUIT UP

Uju Ugoka and **Hannah Young** took to the court for the first time as Hokies on Dec. 22, 2012 against Wake Forest. Ugoka set out the first nine games of the season while Young is just joining the Hokies for the second semester.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIME

Freshman **Lauren Evans** recorded her first career double-double with 10 points and 10 assists against Longwood on Dec. 1.

NOTEWORTHY

CHALLENGE ACCEPTED

Virginia Tech defeated Wisconsin, 47-38 to secure a win in the 2012 ACC/Big Ten Challenge. **Monet Tellier** knocked down 17 points as the Hokies downed the Badgers. The win marked the first for Tech in the Challenge since defeating Minnesota in 2007.

NO POINTS FOR YOU

The Hokies held George Washington to just 31 points on Nov. 25 as Tech picked up a 50-31 win over the Colonials. The 31 point mark tied the team record for fewest points allowed. The original mark was set during the 2009-10 season against Presbyterian.

FROM OUTSIDE

Virginia Tech and Appalachian State combined to tie a Cassell Coliseum record on November 14 in three pointers made. The Hokies knocked down nine while the Mountaineers tallied eight. The record of 17 has been set two other times, in 2002 vs. UT-Martin and in 1993 vs. Southern Miss.

SUIT UP

Four freshmen newcomers made their Division I debut as **Taijah Campbell**, **Lauren Evans**, **Alex Kiss-Rusk** and **Alexis Lloyd** took to the floor for the first time in the Virginia Tech uniform in the season opener against Old Dominion. Campbell also recorded her first career start.

RETURNING CORE

The Hokies return their top four scorers from last season. **Monet Tellier** led the team, averaging 13.7 points per game. **Aerial Wilson** added 12.1 points per game and upped her averaged to 13.0 in ACC contests. **Alyssa Fenyn** added 7.8 ppg and led the team in assists with 88 and steals with 49. **Porschia Hadley** tallied 5.6 ppg.

WELCOME TO BLACKSBURG

The Hokies welcome five newcomers to the team this season. Freshmen **Lauren Evans**, **Alexis Lloyd**, **Alex Kiss-Rusk** and **Taijah Campbell** as well as JUCO transfer **Uju Ugoka**.

STARRING THE FRESHMEN

Lauren Evans and **Alexis Lloyd** were tabbed four-star recruits by ESPN HoopGurlz while **Alex Kiss-Rusk** and **Taijah Campbell** were recognized as three-star recruits.

ON THE NATIONAL STAGE

Alexis Lloyd played for Whitney Young High School in Chicago, Ill. Whitney Young finished the 2011-12 season as the No. 3 high school team in the country and claimed the Illinois 4A state title.

JUCO HONORS

Uju Ugoka was a standout JUCO athlete and was a top-3 finalist last season for the National JUCO Player of the Year honor.

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

In his inaugural season with the Hokies, Wolff guided Virginia Tech to an improved ACC record that featured a milestone win over then-ranked No. 8 Maryland. Tech's win over the 2012 ACC Champion Terrapins marked the first time in over a decade that the Hokies have defeated a team ranked eighth or better and just the third time in team history.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut. Matt played basketball at Boston University and Michael plays ice hockey for Brown.
