#### THE HOKIES

Virginia Tech opened the season with a decisive 84-32 win over Howard as six players hit double-digit points for the Hokies. Freshman Maddison Penn led the charge, tallying 13 points. Sophomore Hannah Young posted her first career double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds. Taijah Campbell Nia Evans and Monet Tellier added 12 points each while Uju Ugoka tallied 11.

Tellier and freshman Vanessa Panousis dished out six assists each and Campbell recorded two blocks and a steal for the defensive side.

The 84 points scored by the Hokies marked the most points scored by Tech since a win over Alcorn State on Dec. 29, 2010. It also marked the most points scored in a season opener since the Hokies defeated High Point 103-64 to start the 2007-08 season. With the win the Hokies improved to 29-9 in season openers.

#### THE LADY MONARCHS

Old Dominion enters its inaugural year in Conference USA. The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish sixth in the CUSA preseason poll and Shea Kelley was tabbed to the preseason all-conference team. ODU return four starters from last season's team that finished the season 19-11 and earned a bid to the WNIT after finishing fourth in the CAA.

The Lady Monarchs claimed a 97-67 win over Delaware State to open the season on Saturday. Stephanie Gardner led ODU with 21 points. Kelley connected for 13 points while tallying 12 rebounds, six assists, five steals and two blocks. Chelisa Painter notched 11 points and Galaisha Goodhope recorded 10 points.

#### THE SERIES

This marks the 28th meeting between the two teams in a series that dates back to the Hokies inaugural season, 1976-77. Old Dominion holds the 20-7 lead in the series and won last season, 55-35 in Blacksburg. Nia Evans and Porschia Hadley had eight points each for the Hokies. Top returner for the Lady Monarchs is Shae Kelley who tallied 14 points.

The Hokies won the last meeting in Norfolk, however, with a 77-65 win on Nov. 11, 2011. Tellier knocked down 29 points for Tech. Ashley Betz-White recorded 22 for ODU.

**UP NEXT:** The Hokies will return to Cassell Coliseum to host the SEC's Florida on Thursday, Nov. 14. Game time is slated for 7 p.m.

## NOTEWORTHY

## PUTTING UP POINTS

The 84 points scored by the Hokies against Howard marked the most points scored by Tech since an 87-44 win over Alcorn State on Dec. 29, 2010. It was also the first time the Hokies have beaten a team by more than 50 points since a 105-40 win over Southern Miss on Dec. 28, 2004.

## OPENING SUCCESS

The Hokies improved their all-time season opening record to 29-9 with the win over Howard. Tech also has a 21-4 record when playing the season opener at Cassell Coliseum.

## BALANCED ATTACK

Virginia Tech opened the season with a win over Howard as the Hokies put together a balanced attack enroute to the 84-32 win. It marked the first time in three seasons that the Hokies have had six players hit double-digit scoring in the same game. **Maddison Penn** led the charge with 13 points. **Taijah Campbell**, **Monet Tellier** and **Nia Evans** had 12 points while **Hannah Young** and **Uju Ugoka** added 11 each.

## POINT PRODUCERS

The Hokies return four of their top five scorers from last season including **Monet Tellier** (13.2 ppg), **Uju Ugoka** (12.5 ppg), **Taijah Campbell** and **Lauren Evans** (4.7 ppg).

## RECORD SETTING

**Monet Tellier** led the team in 2012-13, averaging 13.2 points per game en route to setting the Virginia Tech single-season ACC scoring record with 396 points. Tellier also broke the Tech ACC career record for scoring and enters the season with 549 ACC points.

## JOIN THE CLUB

**Monet Tellier** hit the 1,000 point mark last season in Tech's win over then-No. 19 Florida State. She posted 24 points in the game, becoming just the eighth Virginia Tech women's basketball player to top the 1,000 point mark as a junior.

## I'LL TAKE THAT

The Hokies set the single-season team record last year for rebounds in ACC games, recording 636 versus league opponents.

## SUIT UP

The Hokies welcome five freshmen to the team this season, including **Serafina Maulupe**, **Vanessa Panousis**, **Maddison Penn**, **Samantha Hill** and **Tara Nahodil**.

## INTERNATIONAL STAGE

Four Tech players represented their countries on the international stage over the summer. **Taijah Campbell** competed for Canada's Senior Developmental team at the World University Games. **Samantha Hill** represented Canada while **Maddison Penn** and **Vanessa Panousis** both represented team Australia at the FIBA U19 World Championships.

## WELCOME TO BLACKSBURG

In addition to newcomers on the court, the Hokies added two new faces to the bench as well this season, as **Bett Shelby** and **Jermaine Woods** joined the coaching staff. Shelby joined the Hokies after spending time at Seton Hall for the past two seasons where she helped bring in a top recruiting class, ranked 33rd nationally. Woods was the head coach at Maury High School in Norfolk, Va. where he led the team to back-to-back regional finals. **Thomas Joyce** was promoted to Associate Head Coach during the off season.

## NICE TO MEET YOU

The Hokies will play three teams this season for the first time in program history, beginning with Bucknell on Nov. 17. Tech will also face Hofstra for the first time and will play Indiana as part of the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

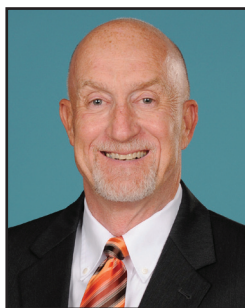

## DENNIS WOLFF

Head Coach • Third Season  
Connecticut, 1978

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

During Wolff's second season guiding the Virginia Tech women's basketball team, the Hokies picked up a big win over a top-25 opponent, defeating then-19th ranked Florida State with a decisive 71-52 win over the Seminoles in Cassell Coliseum. The win snapped an eight game skid against FSU. Tech also improved in its overall and ACC record under Wolff's leadership.

In his inaugural season with the Hokies, Wolff guided Virginia Tech to an improved ACC record that featured a milestone win over then-ranked No. 8 Maryland. Tech's win over the 2012 ACC Champion Terrapins marked the first time in over a decade that the Hokies have defeated a team ranked eighth or better and just the third time in team history.

Wolff was also inducted into the Basketball Old Timers of America Hall of Fame.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut and is currently a social worker in Boston. Matt played basketball at Boston University and now serves as a full-time assistant coach at American. Michael played ice hockey for Brown and currently lives and works in New York City.
