THE HOKIES

The last time out, the Hokies rolled past Clemson, 74-48, on Feb. 27 for Tech's third consecutive ACC win.

The Hokies and Tigers traded baskets early in the opening minutes as Clemson trailed by three with 11 minutes to go, but Tech went on 13-4 run to extend the lead. Virginia Tech took the 34-22 advantage in to the break. Clemson cut it down to a single-digit difference with 15:07 to go, but the Hokies answered with a 25-5 run over the next ten minutes, taking their largest lead, going up 29 (67-38) with 4:10 on the clock and putting the game out of reach.

Uju Ugoka led the Hokies with her 15th double-double of the season, recording 23 points and 11 rebounds. Vanessa Panousis tallied 13 points, including a trio of three-pointers that broke the Tech freshman season record that was set by Sarah Hillyer during the 1989-90 campaign. Hannah Young added 10 points and grabbed nine rebounds.

Ugoka leads Tech on the year, averaging 18.9 points and 9.8 rebounds. She is fourth in the conference in scoring and third in rebounding. Panousis is notching 12.9 points and chipping in 4.1 assists. Monet Tellier is adding 10.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.65 assists.

THE TERRAPINS

Maryland claimed a 92-66 win over Boston College on Feb. 27 in Chestnut Hill, Mass.

The two teams kept it close in the first half and were tied at 29 with 5:37 to go before the Terps used a 21-9 run to take the 50-38 lead in to the break. Maryland dominated in the second half, outscoring the Eagles 42-28 to secure the win.

Alyssa Thomas had 26 points and nine rebounds to lead the Terrapins. Lexie Brown recorded 12 points and handed out six assists. Shatori Walker-Kimbrough added 11 points.

Thomas leads the Terrapins on the season, averaging 18.7 points and 10.8 rebounds per game, in addition, Thomas leads the NCAA in triple-doubles this season having tallied four. Walker-Kimbrough is adding 9.9 ppg and Brown is averaging 9.3 ppg.

THE SERIES

Maryland leads the series 8-6 and won last season 74-45 in Blacksburg. Ugoka had 12 points while Tellier added 11 for the Hokies. Thomas recorded 26 points and 18 rebounds for the Terps.

Virginia Tech won the last meeting in College Park though, defeating Maryland 75-69 on Jan. 26, 2012 when the Terrapins were ranked eighth. Tellier dropped in 31 points for the Hokies while Porschia Hadley recorded 14.

UP NEXT: The Hokies will open the ACC Tournament on Wednesday, March 5 at the Greensboro Coliseum.

NOTEWORTHY

ROOKIE RECORD

Vanessa Panousis broke the Virginia Tech freshman three-pointers made record with the three she dropped in against Clemson, breaking a record that has stood for more than 20 years when Sarah Hillyer tallied 53 in 1989-90.

THREE IN A ROW

The Hokies have won three straight ACC games beginning with 69-62 decision over Pittsburgh on Feb. 20. Tech also defeated UNC, 50-47 and Clemson, 74-48. It marks the first time since 2007 that Virginia Tech has won three straight ACC games.

HERE'S ONE FOR YOU, AND FOR YOU...

Vanessa Panousis broke the Virginia Tech freshman record for assists during the week of Feb. 17-24. The previous record of 106 was set by Carrie Mason during the 2002-03 season.

A FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

The Hokies 50-47 win over No. 11/8 North Carolina on Feb. 23 marked Tech's first win in Chapel Hill in program history.

FRESH-TASTIC

After recording 21 points in a win over Pitt and 24 points as the Hokies defeated UNC, **Vanessa Panousis** was named the ACC Rookie of the Week, earning the honor for the Hokies for the first time since **Monet Tellier** won during the 2010-11 campaign.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE RECORD-RECORD

With 14 points and 11 rebounds against Pittsburgh on Feb. 20 **Uju Ugoka** recorded her 14th double-double of the season, setting a new Virginia Tech record for most double-doubles in a season. It marks the most double-doubles by a Tech player since Kerri Gardin tallied 13 during the 2005-06 season.

NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN

Virginia Tech named **Whit Babcock** its new Director of Athletics on Jan. 24 2014. Babcock, a native of Harrisonburg, Va., has served as the Director of Athletics at Cincinnati since 2011.

O CAPTAINS, MY CAPTAIN

The Hokies and Head Coach Dennis Wolff have announced **Nia Evans** and **Uju Ugoka** as co-captains for the remainder of the 2013-14 season. Evans is a four year letter winner and has been a vocal leader both on and off the court for the Hokies. Ugoka has led Tech this season and is one of three players in the ACC averaging a double-double with 20.2 points and 10.3 rebounds per game.

THREE IN A ROW, TWICE

Senior **Uju Ugoka** scored 20+ points in three consecutive games two times this season. Her first stretch began with 21 points against Bucknell on Nov. 17, followed by 26 at Hofstra (Nov. 23) and 27 against Richmond (Nov. 27). Ugoka had a second three-game span starting with 29 versus Duke (Jan. 19) and 22 in back-to-back games against Georgia Tech (Jan. 23) and Florida State (Jan. 26). The three consecutive 20+ point games marks the first time in a decade that a Tech player has accomplished the feat. Ieva Kublina had three consecutive 20+ point games Feb. 1-9, 2003.

RECORD SETTING

Monet Tellier has set Tech's career ACC records this season in steals, field goals made and free throws made.

BLUE DEVILS IN THE DETAILS

In a 74-70 loss against No. 3 Duke on Jan. 19, the Hokies held the Blue Devils to their slimmest margin of victory since they had a one-point win over NC State in Jan. 2011. In addition, the 70 points by the Hokies were the most points scored by Tech in the series since defeating the Blue Devils, 72-70, in 1998.

SPREADING THE LOVE AROUND

With her 10 assists at Boston College on Jan. 5, freshman **Vanessa Panousis** became the first player with two 10+ assist performances in a single season since Nikki Davis had two such games during the 2010-11 season.

HAPPY NEW YEAR

The Hokies entered the New Year with a 10-2 record, marking the first time since the 2007-08 season that the Hokies have had double-digit wins before January.

SIX STRAIGHT NONE THE RICHER

With 22 points and 17 rebounds against Radford on Dec. 21, **Uju Ugoka** recorded her sixth consecutive double-double becoming just the second player in program history to have double-doubles in six straight games. It marked the first time since 1978 when Karen Garbis tallied six straight from Feb. 9 to Feb. 25.

FROM WAY OUTSIDE

Maddison Penn knocked down five three pointers in Tech's 82-33 win over Radford on Dec. 21. It was the most three pointers in a game by a Virginia Tech player since Monet Tellier tallied five against Maryland on Jan. 26, 2012.

BUCKETS AND BOARDS

Uju Ugoka became just the fifth player in Virginia Tech history to put up 30+ points and grab 10+ rebounds in the same game when she tallied 32 points and 11 boards at Indiana on Dec. 4.

THEY'RE ON THE REBOUND(S)

Taijah Campbell, **Uju Ugoka** and **Hannah Young** each grabbed double-digit rebounds against Presbyterian on Nov. 30. Campbell and Ugoka tallied 12 while Young notched 10 boards. It marked the first time in over 20 years that three Virginia Tech players had pulled down double-digit rebounds in the same game. The last time it happened was on Jan. 21, 1989 in a 68-67 win over Florida State.

300 AND COUNTING

Head Coach **Dennis Wolff** picked up his 300th career win on November 30, 2013 when the Hokies defeated Presbyterian, 55-33. Wolff previously coached at Boston University where he had 247 wins and was at Connecticut College prior to that where he tallied 30 wins.

Uju Ugoka and **Monet Tellier** both hit for over 20 points against Hofstra. Ugoka tallied 26 points while Tellier had 20. The last time Tech had two players score over 20 points in the same game was last season on Feb. 24, 2013 when the duo hit 21 and 24, respectively, against Florida State.

HOT SHOTS

The Hokies hit over 40 percent from the field in each of their first five games. Tech last tallied five consecutive games of 40 percent or better Nov. 24-Dec. 5 2007.

SCORING EARLY AND OFTEN

The last time the Hokies opened the season with five straight 70+ point games was the 1985-86 season, when they opened with six consecutive, but the Hokies were 4-2 during that span. The last time Tech hit for 70 or more in five straight games was Dec. 2004-Jan. 2005 when they tallied seven consecutive games.

DISHING IT OUT

Virginia Tech tied the program's Cassell record for assists in a single game, posting 28 versus Bucknell on Nov. 17. The record was first set against Florida State on Feb. 20, 1988.

IT'S RAINING THREES

The Hokies set new Virginia Tech and Cassell Coliseum records in three pointers made after dropping in 13 as a team against Bucknell on Nov. 17. The previous program record was 12, set on Dec. 13, 1993 at Southern Miss. The Cassell record had held at 10 since Dec. 11, 1996 against Radford.

DOUBLING UP

Uju Ugoka tallied her second double-double of the season and seventh of her career with 21 points and 10 rebounds against Bucknell, becoming the first Tech player to top the 20/10 mark since Brittany Cook had 26 and 14 in 2008 against Maryland.

ROOKIE MONSTER

Freshman **Vanessa Panousis** dropped in 24 points against Florida on Nov. 14. It marked the first time a freshman has scored 20 or more points in a game since **Monet Tellier** tallied 23 against NC State during the 2010-11 season.

WELCOME TO THE FAMILY

The Hokies signed three in the early signing period as **Brielle Blaire**, **Rachel Camp** and **Khadedra Croker** agreed to join Tech for the 2014-15 season. Blaire is a 6-2 forward from Salisbury, N.C. where she has earned All-State honors three times, averaging 14.7 points and 9.9 rebounds. Camp, a 5-11 guard from Forest City, N.C., earned All-State honors in 2012 and 2013 and has averaged 28.4 pints per game and topped the 2,000 point milestone. Rounding out the class is Croker a 6-2 center/power forward from Suffolk, Va. Last season Croker averaged 15.1 points, 13.5 rebounds and six blocks per game and surpassed the 1,000 career point mark.

HALF THE TIME, DOUBLE THE STATS

Hannah Young became just the third Hokie since 2000 to record a double-double in less than 20 minutes. Young had 10 points and 10 rebounds in 18 minutes. at ODU. Porschia Hadley tallied 15 points and 10 rebounds in 16 minutes on Dec. 6, 2009 vs. NC Central. Tere Williams had 19 points, 11 boards in 19 minutes. on Dec. 2, 2000 against Richmond.

DOUBLE DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Hannah Young and **Taijah Campbell** both recorded double-doubles for the Hokies on Nov. 11 in Tech's 73-61 win over Old Dominion. Young had 10 points and 10 rebounds while Campbell posted 19 points and 11 rebounds. The last time two players had double-doubles in the same game was in 2005 with Kerri Gardin (10 points, 21 rebounds) and Erin Gibson (12 points, 11 rebounds) against Virginia.

PUTTING UP POINTS

The 84 points scored by the Hokies against Howard marked the most points scored by Tech since an, 87-44 win over Alcorn State on Dec. 29, 2010. It was also the first time the Hokies have beaten a team by more than 50 points since a 105-40 win over Southern Miss on Dec. 28, 2004.

OPENING SUCCESS

The Hokies improved their all-time season opening record to 29-9 with the win over Howard. Tech also has a 21-4 record when playing the season opener at Cassell Coliseum.

BALANCING ACT

Virginia Tech opened the season with a win over Howard as the Hokies put together a balanced attack enroute to the 84-32 win. It marked the first time in three seasons that the Hokies have had six players hit double-digit scoring in the same game. **Maddison Penn** led the charge with 13 points. **Taijah Campbell**, **Monet Tellier** and **Nia Evans** had 12 points while **Hannah Young** and **Uju Ugoka** added 11 each.

POINT PRODUCERS

The Hokies returned four of their top five scorers from last season including **Monet Tellier** (13.2 ppg), **Uju Ugoka** (12.5 ppg), **Taijah Campbell** and **Lauren Evans** (4.7 ppg).

RECORD SETTING

Monet Tellier led the team in 2012-13, averaging 13.2 points per game en route to setting the Virginia Tech single-season ACC scoring record with 396 points. Tellier also broke the Tech ACC career record for scoring and enters the season with 549 ACC points.

JOIN THE CLUB

Monet Tellier hit the 1,000 point mark last season in Tech's win over then-No. 19 Florida State. She posted 24 points in the game, becoming just the eighth Virginia Tech women's basketball player to top the 1,000 point mark as a junior.

I GOT IT

The Hokies set the single-season team record last year for rebounds in ACC games, recording 636 versus league opponents.

SUIT UP

The Hokies welcomed five freshmen to the team this season, including **Serafina Maulupe**, **Vanessa Panousis**, **Maddison Penn**, **Samantha Hill** and **Tara Nahodil**.

INTERNATIONAL STAGE

Four Tech players represented their countries on the international stage over the summer. **Taijah Campbell** competed for Canada's Senior Developmental team at the World University Games. **Samantha Hill** represented Canada while **Maddison Penn** and **Vanessa Panousis** both represented team Australia at the FIBA U19 World Championships.

WELCOME TO BLACKSBURG

In addition to newcomers on the court, the Hokies added two new faces to the bench as well this season, as **Bett Shelby** and **Jermaine Woods** joined the coaching staff. Shelby joined the Hokies after spending time at Seton Hall for the past two seasons where she helped bring in a top recruiting class, ranked 33rd nationally. Woods was the head coach at Maury High School in Norfolk, Va. where he led the team to back-to-back regional finals. **Thomas Joyce** was promoted to Associate Head Coach during the off season.

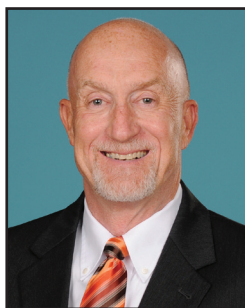

DENNIS WOLFF

Head Coach • Third Season
Connecticut, 1978

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

During Wolff's second season guiding the Virginia Tech women's basketball team, the Hokies picked up a big win over a top-25 opponent, defeating then-19th ranked Florida State with a decisive 71-52 win over the Seminoles in Cassell Coliseum. The win snapped an eight game skid against FSU. Tech also improved in its overall and ACC record under Wolff's leadership.

In his inaugural season with the Hokies, Wolff guided Virginia Tech to an improved ACC record that featured a milestone win over then-ranked No. 8 Maryland. Tech's win over the 2012 ACC Champion Terrapins marked the first time in over a decade that the Hokies have defeated a team ranked eighth or better and just the third time in team history.

Wolff was also inducted into the Basketball Old Timers of America Hall of Fame.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

"I am very excited that Dennis Wolff has accepted our offer to become the head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech," said Tech Director of Athletics Jim Weaver. "Coach Wolff has a great history of successful head coaching experience, and I have had the opportunity to get to know and observe him during this academic year. I believe he fits very nicely into the Virginia Tech athletics family and that he will return our women's program to the winning ways of recent years."

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, played basketball at the University of Connecticut and is currently a social worker in Boston. Matt played basketball at Boston University and now serves as a full-time assistant coach at American. Michael played ice hockey for Brown and currently lives and works in New York City.
