THE HOKIES

Virginia Tech defeated Penn State in the third round of the 2017 WNIT. Chanette Hicks tallied 13 points, six assists and five steals. Vanessa Panousis and Samantha Hill each added 12 points. Sidney Cook and Kendyl Brooks chipped in 11 each. Regan Magarity led on the boards with eight rebounds and posted two blocks.

The Hokies recorded 20 wins in a season for the first time since 2005-06. Tech also set a single-season team record (2,343) for most points scored, breaking a mark that has been on the books more than 30 years. The previous tally of 2,293 was set in the 1983-84 season.

Tech and Penn State traded baskets early in the opening quarter with the Hokies leading by five after back-to-back 3-pointers from Panousis. The Lady Lions drained a 3-pointer of their own, but that was the last bucket for Penn State for the next nine minutes as Tech went on a 20-0 run. Penn State hit just one field goal in the second quarter as the Hokies took a 37-17 lead into the break. Virginia Tech took its largest lead of the game coming out of the intermission off a layup from Cook, but Penn State answered with a 7-0 run to cut the deficit down to 15. Tech kept its advantage, but the Lady Lions used an 11-2 run late in the frame to close it to single-digits. Hill drained a 3-pointer in the final seconds to give Tech a 49-37 advantage heading into the final 10. Brooks hit a long-range basket to open the fourth, but the Lady Lions answered with one on their end. Tech pushed its lead back to 16 just shy of midway. The Hokies maintained a double-digit advantage until the final 62 seconds when Penn State hit a 3-pointer, cutting it to 62-53. Hicks drained a pair of free throws in the final minute to help the Hokies seal the win.

Hicks leads the Hokies, averaging 16.2 points, 5.2 assists and 3.6 steals per game. Magarity is averaging 13.6 ppg and 9.6 rebounds per game. Cook is posting 13.0 ppg and 8.2 rpg while Hill is adding 10.5 ppg.

THE WOLVERINES

Michigan knocked off St. John's 60-40 to advance to the next round of the WNIT. Hallie Thome had 19 points, six rebounds for the Wolverines. Katelynn Flaherty added 17 points and handed out four assists. Kayla Robbins led on the boards with seven rebounds.

The teams kept it close in the opening half and St. John's led 30-29 at halftime. Defense was the key in the second half as Michigan stepped it up, limiting the Red Storm to just 10 points after the break. The Michigan offense was sparked early in the third with a 13-6 run to open the frame.

Flaherty leads the Wolverines on the season with 19.8 points per game, having knocked down 96 baskets from outside the arc. Thome is adding 15.5 points and 7.2 rebounds per game. Siera Thompson is handing out 4.7 assists per game and Jillian Dunston is grabbing 7.5 rpg.

THE SERIES

This is the third meeting between the Hokies and Wolverines. Michigan leads the series 2-0.

The two teams have not met since Dec. 3, 2009 when Michigan won 71-51 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge in Blacksburg. This is the first time the two teams have played in Ann Arbor. The other game was a 79-63 win for the Wolverines in Honolulu, Hawaii on Nov. 29, 1996.

Up Next: With a win, the Hokies would advance to face the winner of Indiana/Villanova in the Final Four. Date and time are TBD.

NOTEWORTHY

LOOK AT ALL THESE POINTS

Virginia Tech set a new team record for most points in a season and has 2,343 entering the quarterfinals of the WNIT. The Hokies break a record that has been on the books for over 30 years. The previous tally of 2,293 was set in the 1983-84 season.

FABULOUS FRESHMAN

With a trio of 3-pointers at Penn State, **Kendyl Brooks** set a new record for most long-range baskets in a freshman season. She broke the record of teammate Vanessa Panousis who set the tally at 58.

PROTECT THE BALL

Chanette Hicks tallied zero turnovers at Penn State. It was the first time this season the sophomore point guard had no turnovers and the third time in her career. Hicks holds a 1.8 assist to turnover mark this season.

ADVANCING

Virginia Tech advanced to the quarterfinal round of the WNIT. The last time the Hokies won multiple games in the postseason was the 2007 WNIT. Assistant Coach **Britney Anderson** dropped in 24 points in the third round game against Auburn.

EIGHT IS GREAT

Vanessa Panousis moved into eighth place on the Virginia Tech career-scoring list. She moved past Chrystal Starling who tallied 1,340 in 1998-2003.

PULL IT DOWN, REBOUND

Regan Magarity has set the Virginia Tech single-season record for total rebounds and enters the Michigan game with 308. She broke Kerri Gardin's mark of 289 set 2005-06. In addition, Magarity already set the Tech single-season record for conference games with 154. Also breaking Gardin's mark of 141 from 2005.

3-IN-A-ROW

With 25 points against Rider, **Regan Magarity** recorded her third consecutive game with 20+ points after tallying 24 versus Clemson and 26 at Boston College. It was the first time since 2014 when Vanessa Panousis had 23, Hofstra; 21, Radford and 24, Western Carolina that a Hokie had three straight 20+ games.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Regan Magarity ranks in the NCAA in double-doubles on the season. Magarity comes in at 22nd with 15 total, averaging 13.8 points and 9.7 rebounds per game. Her 15 ties her with Uju Ugoka (2013-14) for most double-doubles in a season. **Sidney Cook** is ranked 42nd with 12 on the year.

SMARTY PANTS

Virginia Tech had three make the ACC All-Academic team and were represented by **Regan Magarity**, **Vanessa Panousis** and **Sami Hill**. This makes the third academic team honor for Panousis. It marks the most Hokies on the academic team in a season since Laura Haskins, Brittany Cook and Amber Hall earned the honors in 2008.

AROUND THE BLOCK

Regan Magarity recorded six blocks against Clemson, setting a Tech record for most blocks in an ACC Tournament game. It also moved her into the top-10 on the Hokies' single-season record list. She has 49 this year.

HOKIES FROM DOWNTOWN, PT. 2

Virginia Tech has set a new single-season record for 3-pointers made. The Hokies have tallied 237 this year, breaking the previous marking of 192 set last year.

HOKIES FROM DOWNTOWN

Virginia Tech set a new program record with 15 3-pointers at Boston College. The Hokies eclipsed the old mark of 14 set several times in the history of the program.

BROOKS' BOMBS

Freshman **Kendyl Brooks** knocked down seven 3-pointers at Boston College. It was the second most in a game overall and tied the most in an ACC contest. The last time a Tech player had 7+ in a game was Lindsay Biggs with seven in 2009 at Maryland.

MAGARITY'S MARKS

Regan Magarity recorded 26 points and 16 rebounds at Boston College after posting 24 points and 17 rebounds against North Carolina earlier in the season. The tallies make 21 times in program history that a player has eclipsed 20+/15+. It is also just the second and third times it has happened versus ACC opponents. Kerri Gardin had 22 points, 16 rebounds versus FSU in 2005.

PICKING POCKETS

Chanette Hicks ranks fourth in the NCAA in total steals and fifth in steals per game. She leads the ACC in both categories.

HOKIES FOR THREE!

Out of 10 Tech players who have appeared for the Hokies this season, eight of them have connected on baskets from outside the arc. **Vanessa Panousis** leads the group with 66 treys. **Kendyl Brooks** has 60 and **Sami Hill** has 49.

SUPER SENIORS

The Hokies recognized seniors **Sidney Cook**, **Samantha Hill**, **Tara Nahodil** and **Vanessa Panousis** prior to the game against Miami. The group has helped rebuild the program as the Hokies have recorded back-to-back .500+ seasons for the first time since the mid 00s. Last season the quartet helped get the team into postseason play for the first time in nine seasons.

TOP TEN

Vanessa Panousis moved into the Tech Top10 in career points. She became the first Hokie to crack the Top10 since Monet Tellier finished her career (2010-14) with 1,331. Panousis began the season at #21 on the list and surpassed Amy Byrne (1,291; 1986-90) for 10th place.

BLOCK PARTY

With two against Virginia, **Regan Magarity** surpassed the single-season blocks record in ACC contests. The mark moves her past Nare Diawara who tallied 23 in 2006-07.

STEALING THE SEASON

With her first steal of the game against Louisville, **Chanette Hicks** set a new single-season record. The Tech sophomore set the record last year with 91 as a freshman. She tallied seven in the game versus the Cardinals. Hicks also has the steals mark for a sophomore campaign, breaking Sandy Berry's 70 from 1978-79.

LENDING A HAND

Chanette Hicks has set the Virginia Tech assists record for a sophomore season. She breaks Lisa Witherspoon's sophomore tally of 124 set 1996-97. Hicks set the freshman class record last year finishing with 134.

FAVORABLE FRAMES

Virginia Tech's 29 points in the second quarter against the Yellow Jackets and in the fourth quarter against the Panthers marks the most scored by the Hokies in a quarter in ACC play. They also tie three other games overall.

NOTEWORTHY (CONT.)**MOVING UP**

Two Hokies moved up on career lists against Notre Dame. **Chanette Hicks** moved into the top-5 on the Tech career steals list while **Vanessa Panousis** moved into the top-3 of career starts.

I'LL KEEP THIS

Virginia Tech held Syracuse to just six steals in the game against the Orange despite SU averaging 12.6 steals per game. On the flip side, the Hokies tallied eight, including six by **Chanette Hicks**.

STRAIGHT DOUBLES

Regan Magarity recorded seven consecutive double-doubles, breaking the program record of six set twice previously: Uju Ugoka hit it in 2013 while Karen Garbis held the original record with six in 1978.

HOT START: ACC EDITION

Virginia Tech got off to a 3-1 start in league play. It marks the best conference start through the first four games in program history. Previous bests were 2-2 in 2015-16, 2011-12, and 2004-05.

PROTECTING THE BALL

The Hokies gave up just six turnovers in the win over Wake Forest on Jan. 16, tying the fewest amount of team turnovers in a game. Tech also had six at Georgia Tech in 2015 and at Notre Dame in 2002. On the season, the Hokies are one of the best teams in the NCAA at protecting the ball, ranking in the top-10 in turnovers per game and fewest total turnovers.

SOPH STEALS

Chanette Hicks has already set the sophomore class steals record this season when she scooped one up at Miami. She broke the 38-year-old record of 70 set by Sandy Berry in 1978-79. Hicks already holds the freshman class record, single-season record, single-season ACC record and has broken in to the career top-10 list.

HOT START

The Hokies opened the season 15-0, marking the program's second best start. The best start was an 18-0 clip in 1998-99.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Three Hokies recorded double-doubles in the game against North Carolina. **Regan Magarity** had 24 points, 17 rebounds; **Sidney Cook** tallied 16 points, 13 rebounds; while **Chanette Hicks** had 10 points, 10 assists. It is just the third time in program history the feat has been achieved. The last time three Tech players had double-doubles in a game was 2010 with Monet Tellier (14 pts, 10 rebs), Alyssa Fenyn (10 pts, 10 rebs) and Nikki Davis (16 pts, 12 rebs) against William & Mary.

FIERY FIRST HALF

Virginia Tech scored 52 points in the first half against Delaware State, marking the most points scored in the opening 20 minutes since the Hokies dropped in 53 versus High Point in 2007.

NON-CONFERENCE DOMINANCE

The Hokies went undefeated in the non-conference for just the fourth time in program history. The other seasons Tech went undefeated in the non-conference were 2005-06, 2003-04 and 1998-99.

RECORD WORTHY

With 13 assists at Auburn **Chanette Hicks** tied the Tech single-game assist record. Lisa Witherspoon hit the mark twice in 1999 while Lisa Leftwich set the record in 1992.

BACK-TO-BACK

With 92 points scored against Auburn, it is just third time in program history the Hokies have scored 90+ in back-to-back games. Tech tallied 98 vs. BGSU in the previous game.

SENSATIONAL SIX

Six Hokies hit double-digits against Bowling Green on Dec. 11. It was the first time six players had more than 10 points in a game since Howard on Nov. 9, 2013.

ALL THE POINTS

The 98 points the Hokies scored against Bowling Green marked the most by the program since dropping in 103 against High Point to open the 2007-08 season.

QUALITY QUINTET

Five players scored in double-digits for the Hokies against Gardner-Webb, marking the first time in two seasons (Wake Forest, Jan. 23, 2015) that five players have scored 10+ in the same game.

WE'RE BACK

Virginia Tech cracked into the Top-25 for the first time in over a decade on Dec. 5. The last time the Hokies were ranked was Jan. 23, 2006 at 25th.

CHALLENGE ACCEPTED

The Hokies defeated Nebraska on Dec. 1, to pick up a win in the 2016 ACC/BigTen Challenge. Tech helped the ACC retain the crown and won their second straight challenge contest, marking the first time in program history the Hokies have won back-to-back games in the challenge.

ON THE LIST

The Hokies win over #17/16 Tennessee was not only a noteworthy win for the program, but for head coach **Kenny Brooks** as well, marking the third best win over a ranked opponent:

- #11 Old Dominion 76-63 (2007-08, JMU)
- #14 Virginia 75-63 (2009-10, JMU)
- #17 Tennessee 67-63 (2016-17, VT)
- #18 Gonzaga 72-63 (2014 NAAs, JMU)
- #23 UCLA 91-87 (2014-15, JMU)

HONORED

Chanette Hicks was named the espnW National Player of the Week as well as ACC co-Player of the Week after leading the Hokies to wins over College of Charleston and #17/16 Tennessee. Hicks averaged 23.0 ppg, connecting on 48.4 percent from the field. She also tallied 14 steals, including eight against the Lady Vols.

PANOUSIS FOR THREE!

Senior **Vanessa Panousis** became the Virginia Tech all-time career leader in 3-pointers made on Nov. 16 against Presbyterian with her long distance shot made with 6:05 to go in the game. She moved into the top spot, eclipsing Carrie Mason who tallied 200 treys in 2002-06.

The Hokies opened the **Kenny Brooks** coaching era with a 71-52 win over UNC Asheville on Nov. 11.

STARTING SUCCESS

Virginia Tech improved to a season opening record of 40-10 all-time including a 21-4 tally at home.

RETURNING FOR 16-17

The Hokies return three starters from last season's team that finished with an 18-14 overall record and helped the program to its first postseason appearance in nine years as Tech received an at-large bid to the WNIT. Last year also marked the first winning season for the Hokies since 2006-07.

WELCOME TO BLACKSBURG

Kenny Brooks takes the helm of the Virginia Tech women's basketball team this season. Brooks compiled a 337-122 (.756) record during 14 seasons at James Madison, guiding the Dukes to 11 consecutive postseason appearances including six NCAA bids and five trips to the WNIT. Over 11 seasons at JMU, Brooks' squads never won fewer than 24 games, averaging 26.3 wins per year over that span.

MEMBER OF THE CLUB

Senior **Vanessa Panousis** hit the 1,000 point mark last year becoming the 24th member of the 1,000-point club and just the ninth player to do so as a junior. In addition, Panousis set the Virginia Tech career record for 3-pointers made in ACC games.

FANTASTIC FRESHMAN

Sophomore **Chanette Hicks** had a big freshman season, setting four new program records. Hicks set the new marks for single-season steals overall, steals in an ACC season, freshman class steals and freshman class assists. Hicks set the new single-season steals record and the assist record during the opening round WNIT game versus Elon. She

broke the previous record that was set in 1998-99 by Lisa Witherspoon with 86. The freshman class assist record was set by Hicks' teammate Vanessa Panousis with 121 in 2013-14. She broke the ACC season record and freshman class steals records during conference play.

SID THE KID

Senior **Sidney Cook** led the Hokies in scoring and rebounds last season. She averaged 10.7 points per game and upped her average to 11.7 in ACC games. Cook posted 5.8 rebounds per game and led the Hokies in scoring in a 11 games and rebound in 10.

MILESTONE MOMENTS

The Hokies had several program milestones last season, including a 57-43 win over then-No. 8 Tennessee, marking Tech's first win over a top-10 team since Tech knocked off then-No. 8 Maryland in 2012. It was also the program's first win over the Lady Vols and snapped UT's 44-game home win streak. The win over Tennessee followed Tech's 64-59 victory over Penn State in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, marking the first time since 2003-04 that the Hokies picked up back-to-back wins over non-conference Power 5 opponents.

NEW KIDS IN TOWN

Virginia Tech added six players to the roster this season with juniors **Diandra DaRosa** and **Erin Garner**, sophomore **Michelle Berry** and freshmen **Kendyl Brooks** and **Kaela Kinder**.

KENNY BROOKS

Head Coach ▪ First Season
James Madison, 1992

Kenny Brooks was named the seventh head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 28, 2016.

Brooks joined the Hokies after an impressive 14-season stint as head coach at James Madison University where he compiled a record of 337-122 (.756), making him the winningest coach in that school's history. Brooks guided the Dukes to 11 consecutive postseason appearances, including six NCAA bids and five trips to the WNIT. Under his direction in 2015-16, JMU compiled a 27-6 record, including a 17-1 mark in conference play, as the Dukes made a third straight trip to the NCAA tournament.

Over 11 seasons at JMU, Brooks' squads never won fewer than 24 games, averaging 26.3 wins per year over that span. The Dukes won three consecutive (2014, 2015, 2016) Colonial Athletic Association championships under Brooks' tutelage and captured five conference titles over a seven season span. He was named CAA Coach of the Year for a fourth time in 2015-16, while his student-athletes also garnered CAA Player and Rookie of the Year honors.

Brooks registered winning campaigns in 13 of his 14 seasons in Harrisonburg, ascending to No. 23 in the AP Top 25 and No. 21 in the USA Today Coaches Poll in 2014-15 as his squad tied a school record with 29 victories. In 2013-14, he led the Dukes to their first NCAA Tournament victory since 1991 when his 11th-seeded Dukes knocked off sixth-seeded Gonzaga 72-63 in the first round. In 2007, the Dukes earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament, marking only the second time a CAA team had received an at-large berth.

Under Brooks, James Madison tallied six CAA Players of the Year, three Rookies of the Year and two Defensive Players of the Year. The Dukes also earned 31 All-CAA selections, 11 Defensive team and 10 All-Rookie team selections during his tenure.

The Waynesboro, Virginia, native, has coached two WNBA Draft picks, including first-round pick Tamera Young and most recently (April 2015) third-round selection Lauren Okafor, in addition to three other players who have signed professional contracts.

A 1992 graduate of James Madison, he played three seasons under legendary coach Lefty Driesell and made two NIT appearances while earning a degree in business management. He began his coaching career as a part-time assistant for the 1993-94 JMU men's squad that won the CAA Tournament and advanced to the NCAA tournament.

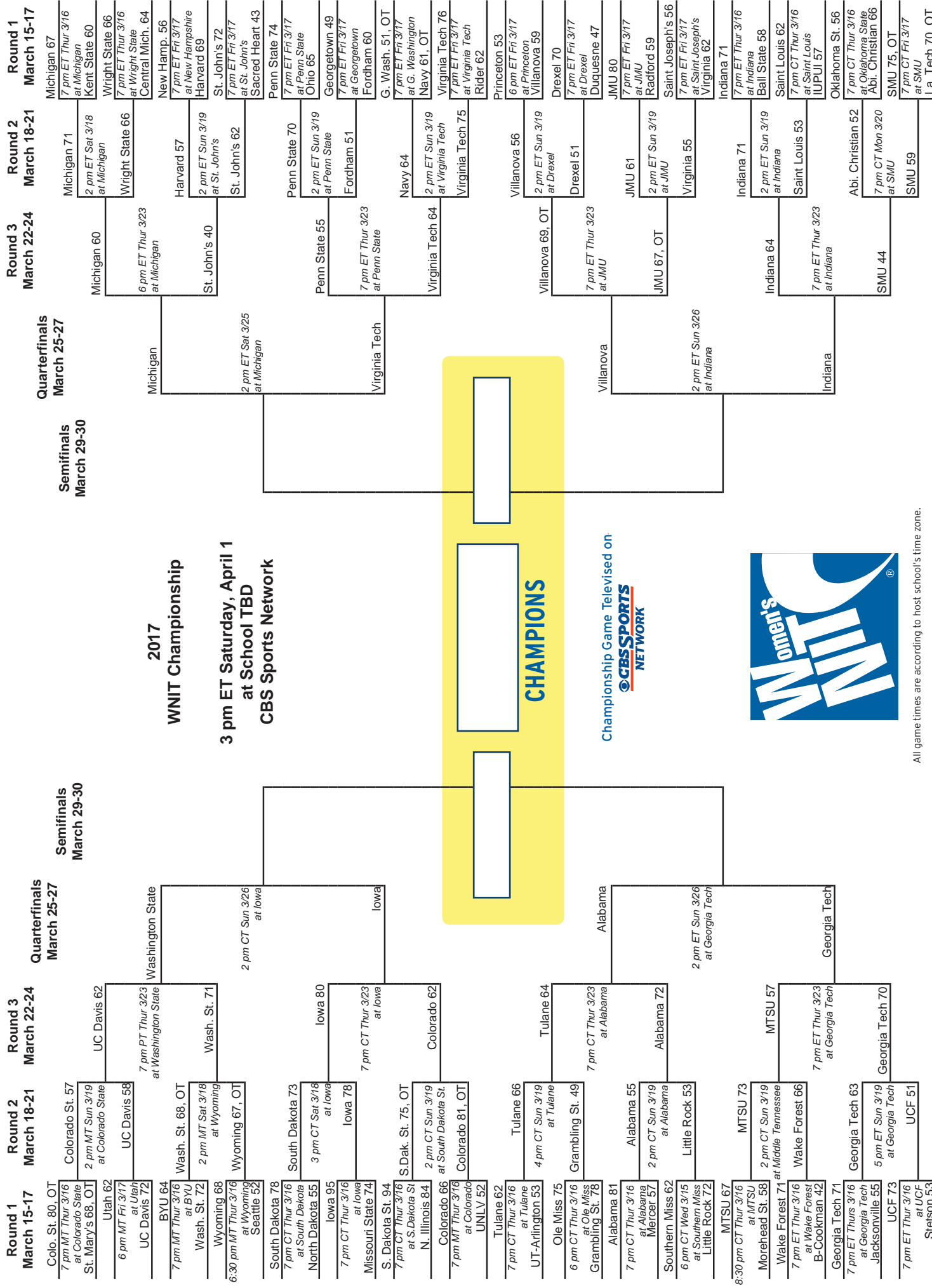
