MATCH NOTES

Last Time Out: Last Sunday, Virginia Tech dropped a hard-fought 1-0 decision to Florida State in the Hokies' first ACC Tournament Final since the 2008 season. Despite the loss, Tech was named as one of four No. 1 seeds in the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history when the bracket was released on Monday afternoon.

The Hokies Thus Far: The Hokies enter the NCAA Tournament with a 16-4-2 record this season, tied for the Virginia Tech all-time record for wins in a single season. Tech has also scored 47 goals this year, making it the highest-scoring Hokie offense in school history, breaking last season's record of 45 goals.

Jazmine Reeves' pair of goals in the ACC Semifinal gave her 10 this year to lead Tech. The senior is followed closely by Murielle Tiernan, whose goal last Friday was her ninth of the season, and Ashley Meier, who has scored eight times. With her two assists in the semifinals, junior Kelsey Loupee now has nine in 2013, tied for the third-most in a single season at Virginia Tech.

Scouting the Retrievers: UMBC enters Friday's first-round contest as the champions of the America East Tournament, completing one of the nation's biggest one-season turnarounds. The Retrievers finished this year with a 13-5-2 record after going 1-11-5 in 2012. They earned their NCAA berth with a 2-1 victory over second-seeded Stony Brook this past Saturday in the AEC Championship and have won their last four matches in a row.

The UMBC offense boasts a pair of players that have notched 17 points in 2013, with both Alexa Quaranta (8G, 1A) and Jessy Brown (7G, 3A) reaching the mark. Melissa Hummel has not scored a goal for the Retrievers, but leads the squad in assists with six.

Lauren Kadet has played every minute in goal for UMBC, tallying 82 saves en route to 13 wins and a 0.95 goals-against-average.

Series History: The Hokies and Retrievers have only faced off once in the past, a 4-2 victory in Blacksburg during the 1998 season.

NCAA Streak: With their selection on Monday, the Hokies have now appeared in six consecutive NCAA Tournaments. They have reached the Sweet 16 twice (2009, 2011) and this is the highest-ever seed they have ever earned.

RPI Respect: The Hokies have appeared near the top of the NCAA RPI rankings since their debut in the sixth week of the season. Tech appears at No. 7 this week. ACC teams dominate the top of the computer rankings, putting five teams in the top 11 this week.

Potent Offense: The Virginia Tech offense has proven up to the task this season, as the Hokies have racked up 2.14 goals per game through their 22 matches. That figure is tied for the 35th-highest average in the country, and trails only No. 1 Virginia (3.19) in the ACC.

Annual Big Wins: The Hokies' October 13 victory over No. 9 Notre Dame marked the seventh consecutive season in which Tech has defeated at least one team ranked in the top 10. In 2006, the last year that the Hokies went without a top-10 victory, Tech lost by just a single goal on the road against both No. 3 Florida State (1-2) and No. 2 UNC (0-1).

Hokies Contributing Early: With freshman Murielle Tiernan scoring nine times in 2013, this marks the fourth time in the last five years that a Hokie freshman has scored five goals in her first collegiate season. Kelly Conheaney scored nine in 2009, Jazmine Reeves scored five in 2010 and Ashley Meier tallied eight last season.

ACC Success: Tech won nine ACC matches this season, the most conference wins the Hokies have ever earned in a single year. In 2009, Tech went 6-4 in the ACC to set the previous record and followed it up with a run to the Sweet 16 in the NCAA Tournament.

Marathon Woman: Over the course of the Hokies' first 15 matches, Jodie Zelenky did not exit a single match, as the junior defender opened the season with 1,467 consecutive minutes without sub until being subbed out in the 68th minute of the Hokies' October 20 victory over Pittsburgh.

Stonewall Defense: This year's defense has a chance to go down in history as one of Virginia Tech's strongest ever. The Hokies allowed just 13 goals in the regular season and have not allowed more than two goals since a 3-2 overtime loss to Duke last season. Tech allowed 20 goals total last season and 25 in 2011.

Extended Road Trip: Tech's stretch this season in which it played four straight opponents on the road (No. 21 Maryland, Boston College, NC State, Duke) was its longest stint away from Thompson Field since the 2001 season, when the Hokies faced five straight opponents away from home.

Powerful ACC: Ten of the 14 teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference reached the NCAA Tournament in 2012, while five current ACC members advanced to the Sweet 16. North Carolina and Florida State, who will both travel to Thompson Field this season, reached the College Cup in San Diego, Calif.

Returning Offensive Firepower: Tech lost six letterwinners, including four starters, from last year's NCAA Tournament team, but will not miss much on the offensive side of the ball. Of the Hokies' 37 goals in 2012, only three were scored by players who are not on the roster this season. Tech also returns 24 of its 30 assists from last year.

Yensen's Gamewinners: Junior Katie Yensen has made a habit of scoring important goals for the Hokies over the course of her career. Though she has just 10 goals in her career in the midfield, seven of those ended up being the gamewinning goal for the Hokies, tied for the fourth-most in Virginia Tech history.

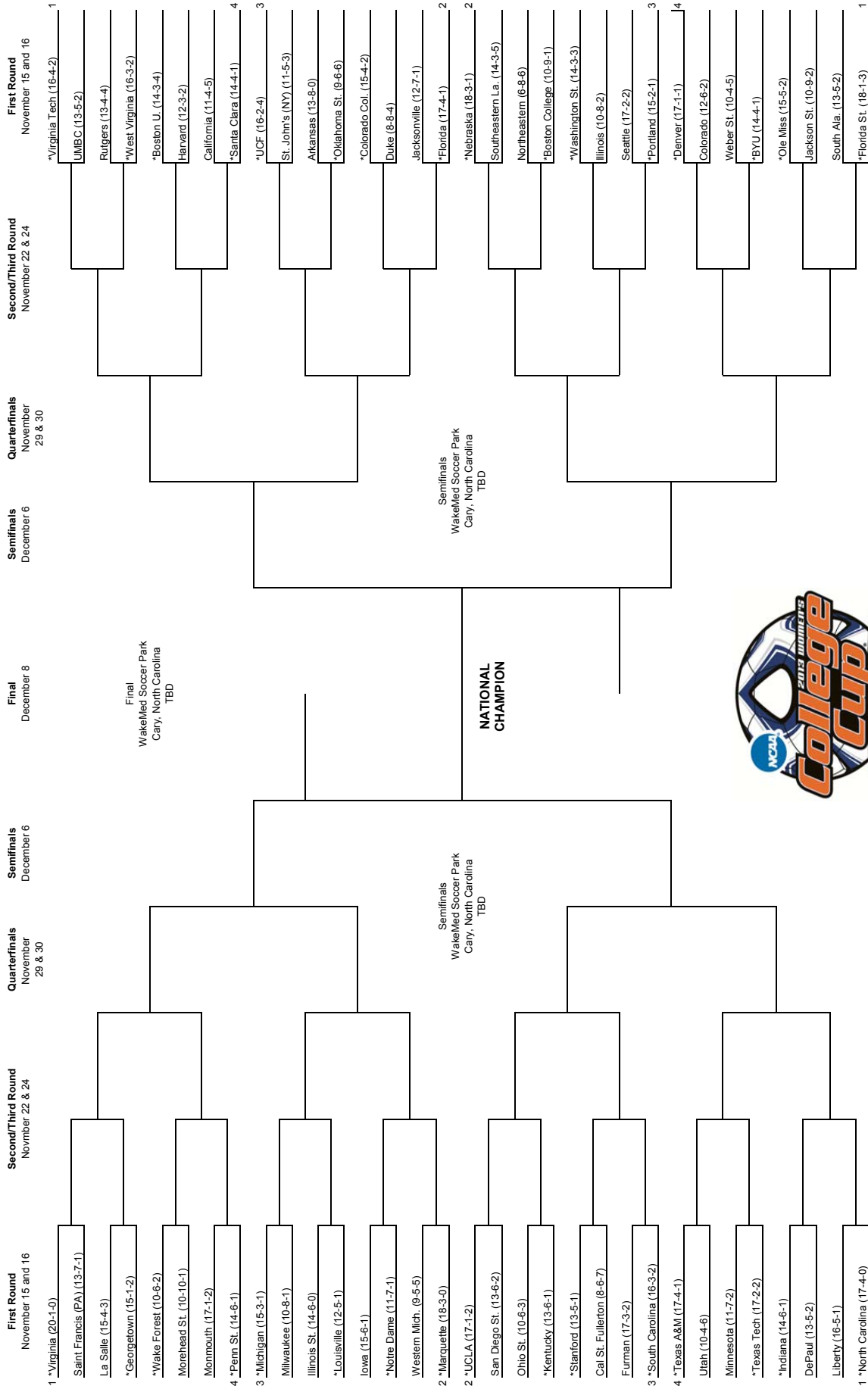
